Tree of Liberty Society was founded by Ben McClintock, a researcher, writer, and organizer with over fifteen years of experience in the liberty movement. Before launching Tree of Liberty Society, Ben served as a field coordinator and regional field director for a national constitutional education organization, and has been featured in USA Today, Fox News, and regional papers throughout the West.

Tree of Liberty Society is unique because it roots its education in the primary source documents of the American founding — the writings, sermons, and records of the men and women who built our constitutional republic — rather than in secondhand summaries or modern reinterpretations. We pair this founding-era grounding with a biblical civics framework, teaching that liberty is inseparable from the moral and religious character of a people.

We are working from the national level down to the local level, planting branches in states and communities across the country. Members study together, teach the next generation, and organize locally to hold government accountable to its proper constitutional role.

The threat to self-government and God-given rights is real — but it is not new, and it is not insurmountable. Every generation of Americans has had to relearn the principles of liberty and defend them against those who would take them away. Tree of Liberty Society exists to make sure this generation does the same.

What do we believe?

We believe the American system of constitutional self-government, established on the principles of natural law, is the finest system of government ever devised.

We believe the Judeo-Christian moral heritage of Western Civilization is the cornerstone of a free society, and that the family and the church are essential to preserving liberty.

We believe that individual rights are endowed by our Creator, not government — that government's proper function is limited to protecting life, liberty, and property, and that rights are inseparably linked to personal responsibility.

We believe in returning to the primary source documents of the founding generation — their own words, sermons, and records — so that citizens can judge for themselves what the founders actually believed, rather than relying on secondhand or politicized accounts.

We believe liberty is not self-sustaining. It must be renewed in every generation through education, faith, and vigilant, informed action.

What do we do?

We produce ebooks, lesson materials, articles, and videos grounded in founding-era primary sources on natural law, biblical civics, and constitutional self-government.

We teach classes and youth lesson plans — including material developed for young men and women learning about agency, liberty, and their responsibilities as citizens.

We research the historical record directly, transcribing and studying original 18th- and 19th-century documents to separate what the founders actually said from modern myth on both sides.

We organize local branches and classes so members can study together and take coordinated action in their own communities — from Eagle Mountain to states across the country.

We report through articles, our TV/Radio programs, and investigative content that exposes those conspiring to erode constitutional government and God-given rights.

Are we effective?

While the work of restoring liberty is never finished, our progress shows we are effective:

- ★ We are building branches of Tree of Liberty Society in communities across the country, not just at the national level.
- ★ Our classes and lesson materials are equipping a rising generation — not just adults — with a founding-era understanding of liberty.
- ★ Our primary-source research is putting the founders' actual words back into the hands of everyday citizens, correcting distortions in both directions.
- ★ Members who complete our educational track go on to organize and teach within their own communities, multiplying our reach.
- ★ We are growing a nationwide network of informed, faithful citizens committed to restoring constitutional self-government.



But our most important success remains building a clear, sourced understanding of the proper role of government, the God-given nature of our rights, and the need for ongoing citizen vigilance — one community at a time.
